








B unches of leaves fall to the ground during this special season known as fall.

L ovey children laugh as they run through the leaves.




A ll of us love to jump in the leaves!

and yellow falling to the ground



A lot of trees will soon lose all of their leaves as the cold approaches soon.


Very soon the leaves will turn brown as they lay on the ground.

L andscapes are covered in fallen leaves


A fter dinner we go for walks through the leaves and,






Long sunny days turn to short days.


